Background

Created in 2020, ASDE prioritized **trainings and networking** to help businesses introduce ESG principles in the strategy and operations, to clarify how to implement SDGs and Paris 2015 global sustainability agenda in Ukraine and Eastern Europe and Central Asia.

The **COVID-19 pandemics** brought new challenges. ASDE helped its members to navigate the COVID lockdown and to help rebuild their supply chains. We focused on building corporate strategy based on ESG principles to ensure robust and quick post-pandemic recovery.

In February 2022, when russia attacked Ukraine, ASDE mobilized its members and partners to tackle the following challenges:

- Assessment of environmental and social impacts of war on Ukraine: what is the new baseline?
- Support to Ukranian small and medium enterprises (SMEs): what are their needs?
- Food security and agribusiness: how to navigate the war and post-war recovery?

Last six months showed us, that **the ecosystem approach** is a cornerstone for successful economic recovery and for keeping on track towards the net-zero carbon dioxide emissions by 2050, while delivering energy security, social cohesion and green transformation.


